- Sessions lasting one week for families



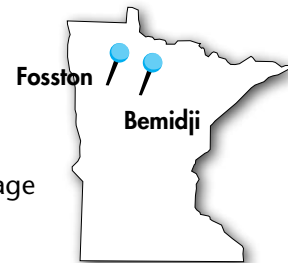

Life at *Lago del Bosco* is infused with Italian. Participants become “villagers” and live in the language and culture from the moment they wake up – participating in small language learning groups, cultural and camp activities, sports, dances, songs – to the close of the day. Counselors from the United States and Italian-speaking countries engage with villagers and share experiences using vocabulary repetition and actions to increase understanding and retention.
